- **Camper arrival** is between 7:45 am and 8:00 am each morning @ the den tarp. An adult must sign-in the Camper each morning with the Den Leader. Opening ceremonies begin promptly at 8:15 am on the hill.
- **Uniform:** camp shirt, camp hat, shorts/pants, and closed-toe comfortable shoes with socks— *NO SANDALS OR CROCS!!!* We suggest wearing an old pair of sneakers. Scouts will be exposed to sprinklers that may soil/ruin a new pair.
- It is a great idea to pack an **extra pair of socks** in a small Ziploc bag to be placed in your child's lunch, so they can change their socks half-way through the day.
- **Lunch:** All participants are responsible for providing his or her own lunches and drinks for the lunch time period. It is advised that each Cub Scout, Kids Korner and Tiger attendees put their healthy lunch inside of a labeled, one gallon zip lock baggie.
 - o **REMINDER:** Due to changes in National Camp Standards, lunches will no longer be offered to Camp Aides or Staff Members. Each Camp Aide and Staff Member is responsible for bringing their own lunch for the day in an appropriate lunch bag to keep cool.
- Any **special medications** should be delivered to the Medical Staff upon arrival each morning in a zip-lock bag with the child's name clearly written on it and a prescription provided, and then picked up each afternoon.
- **Insect repellent and sunscreen** should be applied at home. This is a precaution against allergic reactions. If they wish to bring some to camp, it must be brought to the Medical Staff each morning in a zip-lock bag with the child's name clearly written on it, applied at the Medical Area, and picked up each afternoon.
- **Camper pick-up** is at 4:15 pm @ the den tarp. An adult must sign-out a Camper each afternoon with the Den Leader.
- **If a Camper needs to go home early**, the adult must first check in at the Admin Area, before signing the Camper out with the Den Leader.
- No Camper will be released to any person who is not listed on the Camper's transportation form. Each Den Leader will have a copy of their den's forms. Copies will also be held at Admin for early release of Campers.
- Den Leaders will report any Scouts who did not arrive at Camp by the 2nd rotation Leaders meeting. The Camp Director will follow up with a phone call to the parent confirming the Scout's absence.
- **No toys allowed at Camp...** i.e.: water guns, CD players, iPods, radios, Game Boys, trading cards, etc. Any of these items found at Camp will be confiscated until the end of the day on Friday and must be picked up by an adult in the Admin Area.
